Applications must be postmarked or emailed no later than Friday, February 14th, 2020

Applications must be timely and complete to be considered. All submitted applications will receive an emailed receipt. If you do not receive a receipt, please call the Scholarship Chair.

Application requirements are as follows:

1. Students must be NBVA Members, employees of NBVA members, immediate family of NBVA members and/or their employees (children or grandchildren only).
2. Meet all the requirements for enrollment or continuing enrollment to any of the following higher learning institutions: trade school, junior college, college or university (not including graduate-level education)
3. Previous scholarship applicants may reapply.
4. The scholarship may be awarded for a total of 4 years of education.

Awards are made on a competitive basis with consideration being given to scholastic achievement, social/school involvement, character, and promise. The intent of this award is not to dispense charity, but rather to make it possible to encourage students to secure a university, trade school, or college degree. The scholarship will be granted to the successful applicants and announced at the NBVA annual conference. The recipient(s) will be given their monetary award upon notification of student's enrollment by the institution they will be attending. The award amount will depend on the funds generated at the NBVA conference in March 2020. The number of scholarships, amount of scholarship, and recipient of scholarship(s) will be determined at the discretion of the NBVA scholarship committee.
